Regarding the fall semester of the academic year 2020-2021 (Sept. 3)

At the 15th Novel Coronavirus Emergency Response Headquarters Meeting held on August 28, the following was decided:

1. Tenri University's activity standard in relation to the spread of COVID-19

The activity standard as of September 1 is "Phase II."

*Although the spread of infection is suppressed in Nara, the spread of infection is seen in Osaka and Kyoto.

*Regarding the outbreak in the dormitory of the Rugby team, PCR tests were conducted by all students and staff by August 18. All those who tested positive underwent the proper treatment and/or procedures and was admitted by the health center that "there is no longer risk to pass it on to other people." They have been discharged from the hospital or center. Those who tested negative have completed the follow-up period of two weeks by isolation in private rooms at the campus facilities, etc. The COVID-19 is now suppressed on campus.

2. Fall semester class form (undergraduate)

In principle, classes will be conducted face-to-face, and classes of 51 or more students will be conducted online.

* Class forms of all classes will be announced by September 14.
