### **Notice for a temporary school closing**

The announcement made on our website regarding our students who tested positive was the infection case that sporadically occurred in multiple clubs from the middle of March, and all those who tested positive have recovered by April 11. The activity restrictions have also been lifted on those who were close contacts but tested negative.

All those who have been identified as close contacts after April 12 are undergoing PCR tests sequentially, and the number of people who tested positive is 10 as of April 17. (Those who tested positive are undergoing temporary quarantine measures at on-campus facilities.)

However, in Nara and the neighboring prefectures, community-acquired infections and infections within the home have not subsided, and the situation remains unpredictable. In addition, with the current rapid increase in infected people in the Kansai area and requests from the governors of Osaka and Kyoto prefecture to universities, today, the city of Tenri has requested our University to take a drastic strengthening of infection prevention measure (refer to Tenri city webpage for more information in Japanese).

Based on the above, Tenri University will take the following measures to ensure the safety of students and faculty members.

However, situations may change depending on the infection status of neighboring prefectures and our University.
