Regarding the revision of the activity guideline and the phase which will come into effect from May 24

Tenri University Novel Coronavirus Emergency Response Headquarters Director-general (President) Noriaki Nagao

On May 13, we have decided at the Novel Coronavirus Emergency Response Headquarters meeting to revise the "Tenri University activity guideline in relation to the spread of COVID-19."

This new activity guideline will come into effect from May 24. It has also been decided that the current measures will continue until Sunday, May 23.

1. Based on the new activity guideline, the phase will be raised to "IV" (from May 24)

Tenri University has established activity guidelines for the university in relation to the spread of the novel coronavirus infection. Currently, the infection is spreading in Nara Prefecture and neighboring prefectures. Therefore, compared to the past, it is necessary to deal with daily activities more carefully, so the phase based on the activity guideline is designated as "IV." Phase IV will come into effect on May 24 (Monday).

⁽¹⁾ The Novel Coronavirus Emergency Response Headquarters will hold meetings to determine the level of the phase based on comprehensively judging the situation in Nara, Osaka, and Kyoto, and the request of the government, etc. In addition, upon comprehensive judgment, it may be possible to take measures that are not mentioned above

⁽²⁾ If anyone on campus becomes infected, apart from the phases, based on the requests of the local government, the executive board will determine whether the school will be closed temporarily and campus will be off-limits (no entrance).

2. Please refrain from going out unnecessarily, refrain from social gatherings and so called drinking parties, and try to keep quiet when eating to reduce the risk of infection as much as possible

Infection cases continue to be confirmed at a high level in Nara Prefecture as well as in neighboring prefectures, and in order to overcome the current crisis, it is necessary for each to take measures to prevent infection.

In Nara Prefecture, we are implementing "emergency countermeasures" in order to control the spread of infection with a strong sense of crisis and to promote efforts to save lives with all our might. Please thoroughly implement the infection prevention measures listed on the Nara Prefecture website.

3. In principle, the class format from May 24 (Monday) will be online classes

From April 26 (Monday) to May 23 (Sunday), all classes will be held online, but after May 24 (Monday), in principle, classes will be held online according to the activity guideline Phase IV (with the exception of some face-to-face classes).

At Tenri University, from the beginning of the spring semester until April 18 (Sunday), the classrooms were selected according to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology's "Hygiene Management Manual for the novel coronavirus infection, 'The New Normal of School Life.'" to conduct face-to-face classes.

4. Thorough consideration for students who use public transportation and students who are anxious about attending face-to-face classes

Due to COVID-19, it is understandable that some students will have difficulties coming to campus due to various reasons.

As posted on the Campus Square on May 13, Tenri University has requested faculty members to secure opportunities to attend face-to-face lessons through online distribution and post-distribution of lecture videos, taking into consideration the circumstances of the students, without forcing them to physically come to the classrooms.
