**Regarding class style after November 11 (Thursday)**

On November 3, we have decided the following at the 36<sup>th</sup> Novel Coronavirus Emergency Response Headquarters Meeting:

**1. Based on the activity guideline, the phase will be lowered to “II” from November 11**

Comprehensively judging the current infection status in Nara Prefecture and the neighboring prefectures, Tenri University will set the activity guideline phase to “II” from November 11 (Thursday).

As a result, classes from November 11(Thursday) will be face-to-face for classes with 100 or less students. Due to the lowering of the phase, some of the classrooms that are being used for classes with less than 50 students may change, so please check with the Academic Affairs Section. However, there are some classes that will be held online while preparing for face-to-face classes. Please also pay attention to contact from your class instructor.
